Paracord "Survival" Bracelets are made of braided paracord (parachute cord), which can hold up to 550 pounds. These bracelets not only look cool, but can also be unraveled in an emergency situation to provide 7.5 feet of super strong rope or string if needed.



The outer sheath and inner strands of the Paracord "Survival" Bracelet can be used:

- as a sling, or to tie on a splint
- as sewing thread to stitch wounds or repair gear
- as tripwire, or to make nets and traps
- for many other potentially **life-saving uses!**
