Students are expected to wear FFA official dress. Scrubs are not appropriate nor needed for the State event.

Special Note:

This event covers an enormous amount of material and skills. It is expected that students will develop this knowledge and build on the skills over several years of practice and learning to prepare them for a career in this field. We encourage teachers to reach out to local veterinarians to assist with learning the concepts for this event. As with most fields, there is usually more than one way to perform a task, however the *practicum rubrics were developed using the cited resources to standardize expectations and scoring.* We would suggest taking them to the veterinarians assisting with training so that they understand what students are expected to do in the event.

We anticipate that the event will take 5-6 hours to complete.
