March 6-10, 2021

State Officers, Kyle Schultz and Elsie McKenzie participated in the virtual event with 150 State FFA Officers from across the United States. The major highlights include: International speakers from Japan; conducted agricultural issues by the United Nations; Cultural Foods and Dancing Seminar; African Leadership Academy; Sustainability of food, resources, and economics from around the world.

National Agriculture Day

March 24, 2021

State FFA Officer from across the United State participated in National Agriculture Day celebrations and advocacy training. The three-day workshops from Agricultural Industry leaders, special government guests, agricultural advocacy experts and culminated with a day long series of virtual office visits with Senators, Representatives in the House of Delegates and their staff discussing issues of national importance to the agricultural industry. Shaking Up Ag Education Campaign

March 22-24th, 2021

MidAtlantic Farm Credit hosted eight events across their five-state territory, beginning March 22, to celebrate National Ag Week. The MAFC Association staff and State FFA Officer Teams gave out one free milkshake per person and matched the cost as a donation to the local state FFA organization from that event.

"It goes without saying that National Ag Week is one of our favorite times of the year," Tom Truitt, CEO of MidAtlantic Farm Credit. "It's a time to celebrate all things agriculture – the community in which we live and work. Our goal with these events is to bring awareness to our industry, while supporting the youth in our communities in an engaging way. MidAtlantic Farm Credit staff presented the Maryland FFA State Officers with a check in the amount of \$3,736.00 to support leadership programs conducted through the MD FFA Association at the conclusion of the campaign.

April 6, 2021

Maryland FFA State Officers joined Ms. Mary Muvihill, Visitors Program Coordinator, Department of Legislative Services for the Maryland General Assembly for a virtual tour of the Maryland State House and Legislative Office Buildings. Ms. Mulvihill shared the history of the Maryland State House and many facts about those who have served in the General Assembly with the Officers. The Officers also learned about the process a bill goes through to become a law and followed H.B. 860 Preservation of Agricultural Land as it passed from the House to the Senate.

Joint Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) Training

Maryland FFA State Officers participated in seven virtual workshops throughout the year with the State Officers from the Maryland FBLA and SKILLS USA teams.
